It was witnessing these regular “disasters” affect her community year after year that influenced her choice of profession. Lilia holds degrees in Engineering (with a focus on emergency management), an M.Sc. in Risk Analysis (King’s College London, UK), and a PhD from UBC with a focus on resilience planning. Lilia will be presenting alongside program leaders to share their experiences with Preparing Our Home.
