## Call for Applications to Justice of the Peace Openings

***The Chiefs of Ontario Justice Sector is providing the following posting for information purposes only.***

The Justices of the Peace Appointments Advisory Committee (JPAAC) is calling for applications for current Justice of the Peace vacancies in Ontario. A Justice of the Peace is an independent judicial officer who presides in court over various proceedings under federal and provincial statutes.

There are currently **seven Indigenous serving vacancies**. One each in Toronto, Ottawa, Owen Sound, Sioux Lookout, and Dryden, and two in St. Catharines. Candidates that are Indigenous and/or people with an in-depth understanding of Indigenous languages, history, law, and communities and the issues affecting those communities are encouraged to apply.

Applicants are being accepted until Wednesday, July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024 by 11:59 EST.
