Grand Council Treaty #3 extends its congratulations to Shoal Lake 40 First Nation on the announcement of a new housing development in Winnipeg, MB, supported by over \$51 million in combined funding and expected to create approximately 150 new homes.

The development represents an important step in addressing housing needs while creating long-term benefits for future generations.
